**Communion Assistant
8:00 Service**

*Thank you for volunteering to be a Communion Assistant for our Worship Services.
Listed below are the responsibilities for this position.*

During the Service:

1. At the Invitation to Communion, come to the altar to receive a chalice and purificator from the Pastor.
2. When serving the wine, say, "The Blood of Christ, the Cup of Salvation" or "This is the blood of Christ, shed for you" to each person.
3. You, the Server, and the Pastor will receive last.
4. When done, put the purificator over the top of the chalice and place it back on the credence table.

After the Service: (Wait until after the Dismissal)

1. Help the Pastor and Server to put the remaining elements (leftover bread and wine) back into the sacristy; help them clear the rest of the credence table.
2. With the Pastor, the Server and the altar guild (and anyone else who received communion), consume the elements or pour them into the ground.
